Dear parents/guardians

A) The following will be the schedule for distribution of answer-scripts and result declaration of Annual Examination:

### 1) SCHEDULE FOR DISTRIBUTION OF ANSWER SCRIPTS:

Evaluated answer scripts will be distributed as per the following schedule and it is mandatory that your ward reports to the school to collect the same:

<u>Classes II - V:</u> Thursday, 05 March 2020 (10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.) - Parents are not allowed. (Parents' request(s) for correction will be entertained strictly on <u>Friday, 06 March 2020 between</u> 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon.

<u>Classes VI - VIII:</u> Thursday, 19 March 2020 (7:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.) - Parents are not allowed. (Parents' request(s) for corrections if any will be entertained <u>strictly</u> between 10:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. on the same day).

Classes IX & XI: Thursday, 19 March 2020 (7:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.) - Parents are not allowed. Classes IX & XI students are required to return the evaluated answer-scripts to their respective class teachers after getting the corrections done, if any, on the same day. In case the parents/guardians would like to see the answer-scripts, the same will be available at the time of PTM between 10:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. on Thursday, 19 March 2020 with the respective class teachers.

School buses will be plying on 05 (on 05 March for P.W. buses will leave school at 12:45 p.m. on return) & 19 March 2020 according to the timings mentioned above.

#### II) DISTRIBUTION OF REPORT CARDS:

- (i) Classes Nursery One: Friday, 20 March 2020 (8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.)
  - (a) Students to come along with their parents to collect their report cards on the Result Declaration Day.
  - (b) Report cards of the absentees are to be collected from the respective class-teachers between 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. on the same day. (Authority letter is must in case report card is to be collected by a third person other than the parent).
- (ii) <u>Classes II V:</u> Tuesday, 24 March 2020 (9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon)
  - a) Parents of Bus Commuters and those under supervision will not be allowed to pick-up their wards from the classrooms.
  - b) Report cards of the absentees may be collected on the same day from the respective class teachers between 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. (Authority letter is a must in case report card is to be collected by a third person other than the Parent.
  - c) School buses will be plying on Tuesday, 24 March 2020 according to the timings mentioned above.

#### (iii) Classes VI - IX & XI: Friday, 27 March 2020 (7:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.)

The report card of the absentee students of classes VI - IX & XI can be collected by the students/parents/guardians (with authorized letter) from the respective class teachers on the same day between 10:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.

School buses will be plying on 27 March 2020 according to the timings mentioned above.

B) The new session (2020-21) for classes Nursery to X & XII will commence on Wednesday, 01 April 2020. Students of class VI (class V promoted to class VI) will report to Risali campus and the school timings are from 6:55 a.m. to 1:05 p.m. Under any circumstance(s), late comers of any class (Nursery to XII) will not be allowed, rather they will be sent back home. Hence, parents/guardians are advised to ensure that their ward(s) reaches/reach school on time.

## C) **SUMMER UNIFORM:**

- (i) Classes Nursery to XII Girls White half sleeved shirt without pocket. White skirts not more than one inch above the knee. **Low waist skirts are not allowed.** White leggings (optional\*).
- (ii) Classes Nursery to V Boys White half sleeved shirt without pocket. **Vests should always be worn under the shirt**. White shorts (not more than three inches above the knee for all upto class V) or White trousers (optional\*).
- (iii) Classes VI to XII Boys White trousers for Class VI onwards. The width of the trousers should be between 16 and 18 inches. <u>Drain pipes, bell bottomed trousers, low waist trousers or baggies are not allowed.</u>
- \*We suggest that your ward(s) wears/wear trousers/leggings in order to get them protected from the Dengue.
- D) The school identity card is compulsory (continue to use the old identity card till the new one is issued).
- E) The list of textbooks and stationery to be procured by the parents/guardians for their ward(s) for the next academic session 2020-21 has been posted on our website <a href="www.dpsbhilai.in">www.dpsbhilai.in</a>. The parents/guardians are at liberty to purchase the textbooks and stationery from the shop of their choice. They must also ensure that textbooks and stationery are made available to their ward(s) right from the first day of the academic session (2020-21), so that regularity in academics is maintained.
- F) The *Indoor Swimming Pool* at Risali Sector will open for swimming (**only for students**) on <u>16 March 2020</u>. The membership fee for the season (period 16 March to 15 September 2020) will be Rs. 4,000/- per student.
  - a) <u>REGISTRATION:</u> Registration for membership will be open at the school office <u>between</u> 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon from <u>Wednesday</u>, 11 March 2020 (excluding Sundays and holidays).

# b) **POOL TIMINGS:**

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VI – XII : 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. Boys - Monday, Wednesday & Friday Nur – V : 5:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Girls - Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday SUNDAY WEEKLY OFF
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The pool timings are subject to change. The membership will be available on 'First-come-first-serve' basis since the pool has limited capacity. Membership fee once deposited will not be refunded.
